Subject: COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP - FEMALE STUDENTS ONLY FROM CRAWFORD COUNTY OR CRAWFORD COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES

The Grace High Washburn Trust is a charitable Corporation, organized under the laws of the STATE OF OHIO. It functions under the terms of the WILL of the late Grace High Washburn, a native of Bucyrus, Ohio.

The Foundation grants scholarship of \$ 500.00 per academic year, not to exceed four years, (8) Semesters to worthy GIRLS who are Residents of BUCYRUS, OHIO AND VICINITY, and who are enrolled at The Ohio State University (only) either on campus in Columbus or at any of its branches as a FULL TIME Student which is (12 Credit Hours or more per semester)

No part-time scholarships are provided under the Will.

Remittances to students are made through the Office of Student Financial Aids at The Ohio State University on a semester basis (\$250.00 for Autumn Semester and \$250.00 for Spring Semester), making a total of: \$500.00 for an academic year. Following the granting of these scholarships in April of each year, a reserve fund is set up for amounts granted, and as long as the student maintains grades satisfactory to the University, and full time status, remittances are automatically forwarded to the Office of Student Financial Aid, just prior to each succeeding semester. Students may receive these scholarship monies from that office.

From time to time additional funds MAY become available for distribution within a given year. Should this occur, additional amounts may be included with the regular remittance to students receiving Scholarships. Such additional amounts are not guaranteed and do not alter succeeding remittances. All Grants awarded may be used by the student and no repayment is required, as long as they remain a full time student.

MISSING TWO CONSECUTIVE SEMESTERS MAY CAUSE YOU TO LOSE YOUR SCHOLARSHIP- AS YOU WILL NO LONGER BE CONSIDERED A FULL TIME STUDENT.

Applicants may address a letter of intent to attend THE OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY TO:

Letters may be sent anytime during the year, but must be received no later than March 1.

Upon receipt of such letters, they will be entered into our database. The applications will be sent the first week of March to the applicants. The applications must be completed and returned prior to April 1.

The Board of Trustees will then meet and evaluate the applications and award scholarships to worthy girls to the extent of available funds. THIS SCHOLARSHIP IS NOT AUTOMATIC.

All applicants are evaluated, and advised of the Board's decisions as soon as possible. Scholarships granted will begin with the Autumn Semester of the year the grant is awarded.
